The repair agency is required to contact Thales if they are not able to maintain the existing item configuration. Equipment that is returned for repair or refurbishment after being in-service must be maintained by the use of consumable spare parts identical to those originally installed. If an item requires repair or refurbishment by means other than the use of such consumables (eg welding, bushing, metal spray, use of different materials or parts), this requires the approval of Thales Australia.

Your earliest advice on the expected lead-time for the return of each item would be appreciated.
